



Dear Friends,

We are all deeply grateful that one of our HM Sisters, Judy Dohner who lives and ministers in Haiti, is safe. We have been talking with Sr. Judy and she is currently working at St. Damien Hospital which is near the airport in Port-au-Prince. We, like all of you, are stunned at the destruction in Haiti. We ask that you hold the people of Haiti and the relief and rescue workers in your prayers.

As some of you know, Sr. Judy has been working with the Sisters of St. Antoine in a small clinic in the mountains about 25 miles from Port-au-Prince and also at St. Damien Hospital in Tabarre. The epicenter of the earthquake was about half way between Port-au-Prince and the location of the clinic. One of the Sisters of St. Antoine, Sister Odile, and one of the orphans, Jude Dubic, died as a result of the earthquake. The guest house, school and the new convent which was under construction have all been devastated.

The sisters and the community of Fondwa will need our prayers as well as significant assistance to care for those in need following this disaster. We ask that you prayerfully consider helping us to bring aid to them.
